I, Peter James McCurdy, wish to be a party to the following proceedings:

- Panuku Development Auckland Limited and Auckland Council ENV-2018-AKL-78

I am a person who made a submission about the subject matter of the proceedings.

I am not a trade competitor for the purposes of [section 308C](#) or [308CA](#) of the Resource Management Act 1991.

I am interested in all the proceedings.

I am interested in the following particular issues:

The protection and preservation of Auckland's material maritime heritage

The protection and preservation of berthage for heritage vessels

I conditionally oppose the relief sought (application) because—

There is no clear recognition in the application of responsibilities to protect and preserve Auckland's maritime heritage, so much of which has already disappeared (that is, apart from passing references to the Vos shipyard and to statutory archaeological requirements).

The existing berthage for the heritage vessels *Rapaki* and *William C. Daldy* does not appear on the plans and graphics accompanying the application, and there is no alternative berthage shown or discussed. There is no recognition of future maritime heritage and heritage vessel needs, including berthage for the very last survivor of the Auckland steam passenger ferries *Toroa* now under restoration to seaworthy and authentic state to again carry passengers in steam on the Waitemata. In the economic case, there is no analysis of the potential benefits of a vibrant maritime heritage sector and maritime heritage tourism, nor of the losses in not catering for maritime heritage tourism.

I agree to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
