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MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT

1. This memorandum of counsel is filed on behalf of Vector Limited ("**Vector**"). Vector filed a notice to join as a party to the above named proceeding under section 274 of the RMA.
2. Vector's interest in the Application is on the basis that Vector owns and operates a range of utilities infrastructure and assets within the Application's project area in Wynyard Quarter. Vector's primary objective remains to ensure its utilities infrastructure and assets are protected and provided for, in order to protect the security of supply to Auckland.
3. Vector has engaged in mediation and in ongoing discussions with the Applicant and the Wynyard Edge Alliance. Vector is now comfortable that its assets and infrastructure will be provided for and protected, based on:
 - (a) the amended conditions of consent (dated 7 August 2018), in particular the amended CLG conditions; and
 - (b) the ongoing direct discussions with the Applicant and the Wynyard Edge Alliance.
4. Vector does not wish to file legal submissions or be heard in respect of the proceedings. Accordingly, Vector respectfully seeks leave to be excused from attending the hearing.
