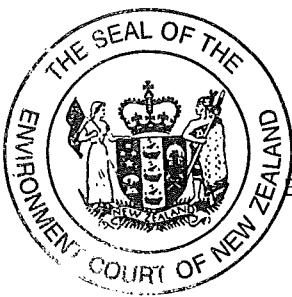

FOURTH MINUTE OF THE ENVIRONMENT COURT (10 JANUARY 2017)

[1] Four applications for waivers in respect of s274 notices from people who did not file their s274 notices within the required time were received by the Court:

- A s274 notice and waiver from Richard Nimmo together with a s274 notice on behalf of Breaker Bay and Moa Point Progressive Association. WIAL does not consent to Mr Nimmo's application nor has the Association applied for a waiver. This matter will be included on the agenda for the pre-hearing conference in early February.
- Susan Haniel who did not make an initial submission to the Council. WIAL does not consent to Ms Haniel's waiver application. This matter will also be included on the agenda for the pre-hearing conference in February.
- The waiver application by Lyall Bay Surf Life Saving Club is not objected to by WIAL. This waiver is approved by consent and the Surf Club is accordingly a party to these proceedings.
- The waiver application by Pauline and Athol Swann is not objected to by WIAL. This waiver is approved by consent and Mr and Mrs Swann are accordingly parties to these proceedings.



[2] Other persons who did not file s274 notices within time and did not apply for a waiver are not parties to these proceedings.

[3] Eight parties wishing to be heard on this matter filed their notices with the Court within the required time but failed to serve copies on WIAL. They were Ian Harrison, Christopher (John) Horne, Mark Shanks, Surfbreak Protection Society Inc, Athol Swann, Pauline Swann, Te Runanga o Toa Rangatira Inc and Rod Tervoort.

[4] WIAL has requested a waiver on those parties' behalf to waive service of those notices on WIAL. These waivers of service are approved by the Court as waivers by consent.

[5] WIAL also requested a waiver of service on behalf of Fiona Kidman but as Ms Kidman was late in filing her s274 notice and has not sought a waiver in respect of late filing she is not a party to the proceedings.

[6] A hearing notice for the non represented parties' advisors meeting on 25 January 2017 is to be issued shortly. A pre-hearing conference notice for the week of 7 February (most likely for Thursday 9 February 2017) will issue on confirmation of a venue.
