- Waikato District Council (WDC) wishes to be a party to the following proceedings: Clause 14(1) of First Schedule, RMA 1991, WAIPA DISTRICT COUNCIL's (Waipa DC) appeal against part of the decision of Waikato Regional Council (WRC) Proposed Plan Change 1 Waikato and Waipa Regional River Catchments to the Waikato Regional Plan as amended by Variation 1 (PC1).
- 2. WDC has made a submission about the subject matter of the proceedings, and has an interest greater than the public generally as a district council whose role includes the management of three waters;

Trade competition

3. WDC is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.

- 5. The relief sought at:
 - (a) Paragraph 2.5 which seeks to amend the short-term target for the reduction of contaminants from 20% to 10%;
 - (b) Paragraph 3.3 which seeks to amend Objective 3 and, in particular, seeks deletion of the word "assisted" and replaced with "enabled";
 - (c) Paragraph 4.8 which seeks to amend Policy 12;

(d) Paragraph 5.6 which seeks to amend Policy 13;

(e) Paragraph 6.5 which seeks to delete Policy 19;

(f) Paragraph 7.2 which seeks to amend Method 3.11.3.3;

(g) Paragraph 8.2 which seeks to amend the explanatory note to

Table 3.11-1; and

(h) Paragraph 9.2 which seeks to amend footnotes 7 and 8 to Table

3.11-1.

Relief Sought

6. WDC supports the relief sought because the amendments sought by

Waipa DC are consistent with the relief that would be sought by WDC.

7. The relief sought by Waipa DC sufficiently covers WDC's concerns

and seeks appropriate amendments to ensure the operative version of

PC1 provides for the protection and maintenance of ecosystem health

while providing for the social and economic activities of the Waikato

region.

8. Such other consequential or alternative relief by way of amendments

to the provisions of PC1 that address the grounds pleaded in the

appeal.

Dispute resolution

9. WDC agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute

resolution of the proceedings.
