MINUTE OF ENVIRONMENT COURT CONCERNING SECTION 87G DIRECT  
REFERRAL

(2 NOVEMBER 2016)

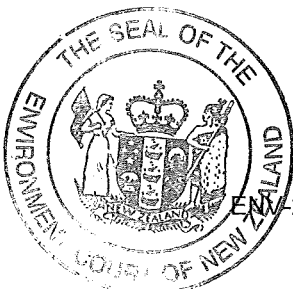

[1] The Court acknowledges receipt on 31 October 2016 from Wellington International Airport Limited (WIAL) of a notice of motion under s87G RMA for various consents enabling a runway extension (including construction, operation and maintenance) and an accompanying application for directions and waiver for service advice for potential s274 parties.

[2] I grant the waivers sought in para 4(a) of the application for waiver.

[3] In respect of para 4(b) I direct that:

- a. Any party who wishes to join the direct referral proceedings may do so by either:
  - Filing a signed s274 notice by email (in PDF format) with the Environment Court to [EnvironmentCourt@justice.govt.nz](mailto:EnvironmentCourt@justice.govt.nz). If a signed copy cannot be filed electronically you must follow up your electronic s274 notice with a signed copy posted to the Court; or
  - Filing one signed hard copy in person at the Environment Court; Level 5, Wellington District Court building, 49 Ballance Street, Wellington or by mail to Environment Court-Wellington Registry, PO Box 5027/DX SX 10044, Wellington 6140.
- b. Following the expiry of the section 274 period, WIAL is to file with the Environment Court a hyperlinked document containing all the section 274 notices that have been filed. The Environment Court will then circulate this to all parties to the direct referral proceedings to ensure

that all parties have a copy of every notice filed during the section 274 period.

- c. I approve the amendment of 'Advice to recipients' contained in WIAL's Notice of Motion. The existing paragraphs (a) and (b) are deleted and replaced as follows:

*(a) On or before 5pm Monday 21, November 2016, you lodge a signed notice in Form 33 (attached to this Notice of Motion) with the Environment Court.*

- i. This can be done by email (in PDF format) to [EnvironmentCourt@justice.govt.nz](mailto:EnvironmentCourt@justice.govt.nz). If a signed copy cannot be filed electronically you must follow up your electronic s274 with a signed copy posted to the Court; or*
- ii. Filing one signed hard copy in person at the Environment Court; Level 5, Wellington District Court building, 49 Ballance Street, Wellington or by mail to Environment Court-Wellington Registry, PO Box 5027/DX SX 10044, Wellington 6140.*

*(b) That you serve a copy of your s274 notice on:*
